Cable Safety – Out of Sight, Out of Mind!

Exposed or loose tournament cables from a variety of vendors increase the potential for a trip and fall incident and detract from the overall tournament aesthetic. Cables need to be properly secured behind a wall, under a floor or ground or in a cable ramp.

What to Look for

- Electrical Cable
- Television Cable
- Internet Cable
- Television Network Cable
- Hose

A Difference Maker



Properly secured and hidden cables minimize the risk of a trip and fall **AND** create an aesthetically pleasing environment for tournament guests.



Cable Installation Plan

- Establish tournament cable needs in advance of the tournament with cable vendors
- Together with cable vendors, create a cable routing map that can be followed and shared by as many vendors as possible
- Assess installed cables prior to opening day to secure or hide any loose cables
- Continue to secure and hide additional cables that are added during tournament week
- Take pictures of the positive and negative cable routing to share with vendors and staff post event for future events

Correcting Loose Cables

- Cable ramp
- Trenching
- Mulch/pine straw
- Garden “U” staple
