Golf Cart Safety – Keep on Rolling with Safety!

Golf cart safety is one of the top priorities when it comes to promoting safety best practices at PGA TOUR golf tournaments. All staff, vendors, players and volunteers should follow our golf cart safety guidelines. Please help us promote a culture of safety!

THINK CART SMART!

Do Not Overload Carts



- ONLY ONE PERSON PER SEAT – no hanging off the back of the golf cart or squeezing multiple persons on the seat.
- Overloading a golf cart is not limited to people. Excess cargo, including boxes, signage, etc. should be transported using a utility or multi-passenger golf cart.





- ALWAYS remove the key when leaving the golf cart unattended.
- Removing the key will ensure that the cart will not drive off uncontrollably if equipment accidentally falls onto the accelerator.
- Removing the key also prevents the cart from being stolen or used by an unauthorized person.
- Do not allow other persons to drive your assigned cart.

Golf Cart Safety Compliance

Before the start of the event, all volunteers and vendors should watch the golf cart safety training video and sign the Golf Cart Safety Acknowledgement Form.



These forms should be submitted to the golf cart committee or tournament staff. As an additional compliance piece, we recommend that your tournament provide "THINK CART SMART" wristbands to individuals who have completed golf cart safety training.



The Safety Buzz for 2018

Effective as of the Safety Open, *all golf carts should have the reverse buzzer enabled before operation. Be sure to always **DOUBLE CHECK** your intended direction to avoid hitting others. Please be aware of your surroundings when using the "reverse" direction so as to minimize disruption to on-course play.
